- On-site interviews are required for selected candidates after review of application materials (contingent on current COVID restrictions)
- Candidates will be notified of a decision no later than February 12




SALISBURY VAHCS

Salisbury VAHCS is a tertiary care facility affiliated with multiple Schools of Pharmacy as well as Wake Forest University School of Medicine and the Virginia College of Osteopathic Medicine. It serves as a training site for students and residents in multiple disciplines: nursing, dentistry, optometry, pharmacy, psychiatry, psychology, rehabilitation, and medicine.

The health care system provides medical, surgical, psychiatric, oncology, and ambulatory care services to over 92,000 Veterans in the central Piedmont service area. It boasts newly opened large Health Care Centers (HCCs) in Kernersville and Charlotte, and a Community Based Outpatient Clinic in Charlotte.

Salisbury VAHCS has clinical pharmacy specialists with prescribing privileges in primary care, pain management, long-term care, home-based primary care, mental health, infectious diseases, hematology/oncology, and acute care. The medical center also provides an in-house Community Living Center and hospice care for Veterans.

PURPOSE

PGY1 pharmacy residency programs build on Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for post-graduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.
